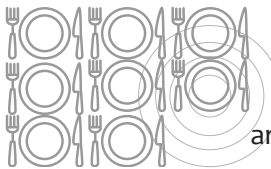

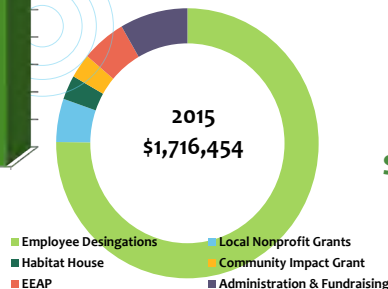
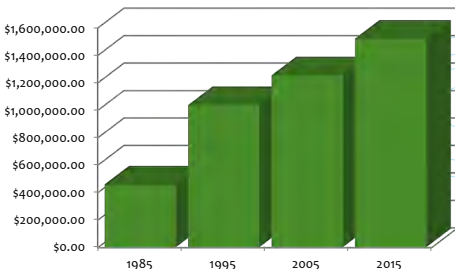


992 UAB employees and students volunteered over **4,500 hours** to build the 2014 and 2015 Habitat Houses
